1. Meeting called to order at 6:32 p.m.
2. Student Affairs report
 - a. NAC Member Terri Mangione shared a report on select addresses on 81st Street, Dunbarton Avenue, and Regis Way.
 - b. NAC Member Mangione announced her retirement, and that Csilla Samay, associate dean of students, international initiatives and special projects, will serve as the interim dean of students as of June 1.
 - c. NAC Member Mangione reviewed reports between January 29 and April 20 for 2025 and 2026.
 - i. There were 16 confirmed reports, a slightly higher number than last year over the same time.
 - d. NAC Member Mangione also highlighted some upcoming events.
 - i. Senior sunset will last until 8 p.m., or when the sun sets, on Friday, May 1.
 - ii. Last day of classes is Tuesday, May 5.
 - iii. Special Well-Done Wednesday on Wednesday, May 6, from 11 a.m. - 3 p.m.
3. L.A.P.D. Senior Lead Officer report
 - a. No attendance or report.
4. Department of Public Safety report
 - a. NAC Member Terry McAllister shared that commencement will be on May 16 and 17. Graduate commencement and the LMU Loyola Law School commencement will be held on May 17.
 - b. NAC Member Linda Kokelaar reported discrepancies between her own reporting and what is reflected in the Public Safety report.
 - i. The reports were not found but NAC Member McAllister said he reiterated to his staff that all calls should be properly documented.
5. Master Plan Compliance Officer report
 - a. No updates on the Master Plan for this meeting.

9. Public comment
 - a. A community member expressed appreciation for the NAC report on the house on Regis Way.
